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LANDSCAPING REMINDERS

- FRONT AND BACK YARDS MUST BE KEPT IN GOOD CONDITION. PLEASE NOTE THE FOLLOWING ITEMS:
- Water and mow grass on a regular basis
- Weeds must be removed from property including tree lawn areas
- All bare ground must be covered with ARC approved mulch or rock
- All dead plants/trees must be removed and replaced

PLEASE REMEMBER THAT ALL LANDSCAPE PLANS MUST BE SUBMITTED PRIOR TO INSTALLATION. ALL LANDSCAPE MUST BE APPLIED FOR AND INSTALLED WITHIN 180 DAYS OF CLOSING.

POOL & SPLASH PAD UPDATES

Both the pool and splash pad are set to open Memorial Day Weekend!

- NEW pool passes will be issues this summer—keep an eye out for an email with additional details! Existing key cards will no longer allow pool access.
- Please note that splash pads are difficult to keep running smoothly. Please take extra care that items such as plastic toys, rocks, mulch, and other debris do not go down the drain, as this will affect the splash pad operation.

CODE & COMPLIANCE NOTES

- Please review the <u>design guidelines</u> (UPDATED AT FEBRUARY 2023 MEETING) and access request forms at the district's website, https://www.trailsidemd.live/ architectural-review
- Competed forms are submitted to info@trailsidemd.com; or they can be mailed to Pinnacle Consulting Group in Loveland.
- Exterior modifications including landscape, sheds, pergolas, decks, raised garden beds, etc. require plan submissions and Architectural Review Committee (ARC) approval.
- Boats and RVs may only be stored on driveways/streets temporarily for loading and unloading.
- All fences within the district are required to be stained. Most homes use Sherwin Williams Tycoon Brown (SW2209.) If your home is on ISABELLA and backs to the trail, please reach out for confirmation of fence stain color.
